



## TOP RYDER COMMUNITY BUS

A FREE, hourly, community bus service operates 6 days a week, Monday- Saturday, 9.30am-3.00pm.

Two buses run the same route in opposite directions between Meadowbank and West Ryde, via Gladesville and Top Ryde City. Signal the driver at any designed Top Ryder or STA bus stop along the route.

Time table and route details are available from Customer Service, Council's website and all libraries. Wheelchair bookings must call a day before travel on 1300 850 820.

Top Ryder Community Bus is a Council initiative in partnership with Top Ryde City Shopping Centre.

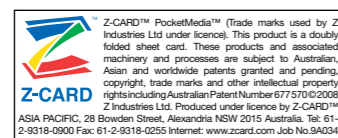

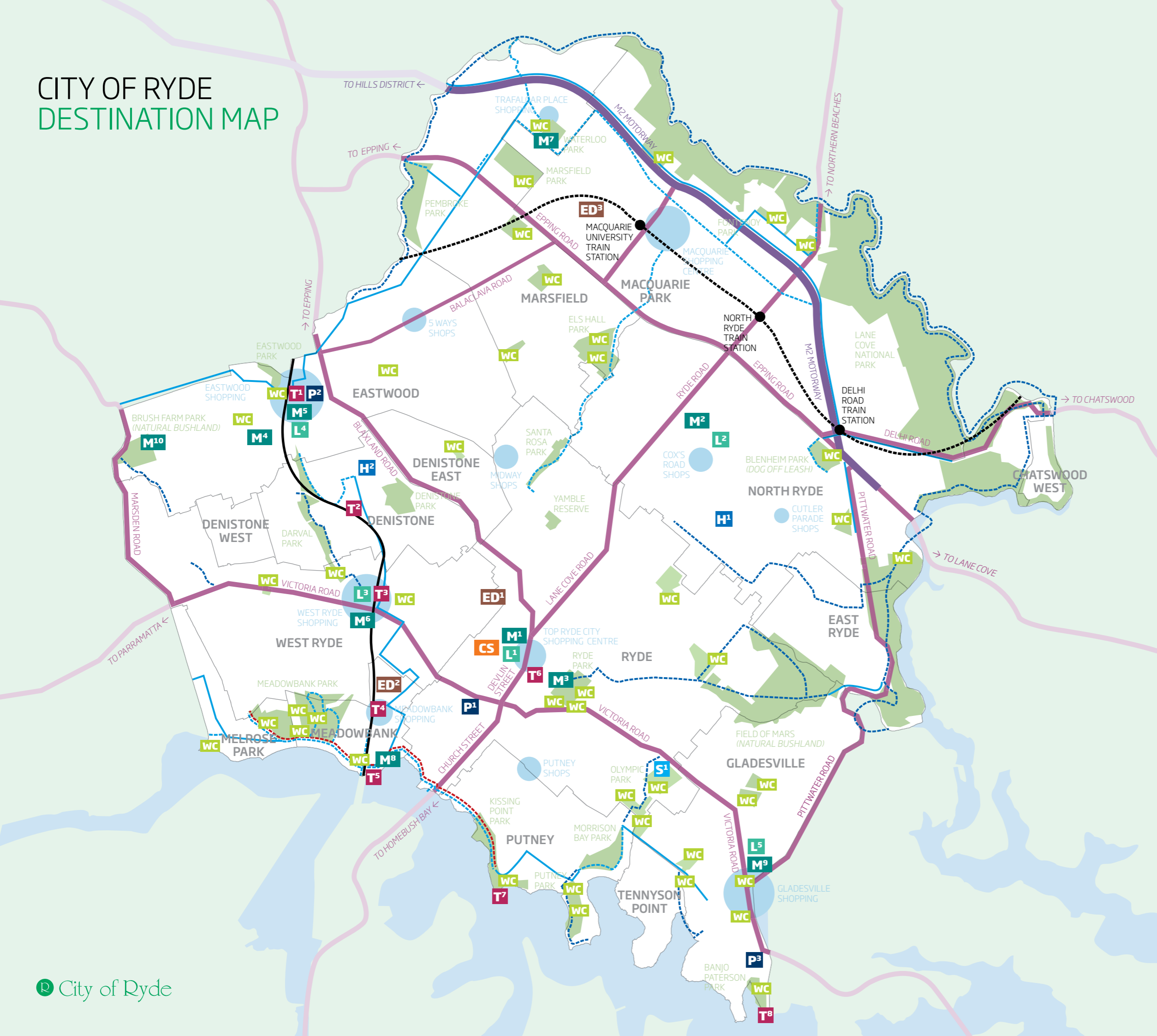
## EVENTS
