

2024 LOCAL PLANNING PANEL **COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES**

The Local Planning Panel makes decisions about sensitive, complex, or contentious Development Applications and provides advice in respect to Planning Proposals. City of Ryde is seeking expressions of interest from interested representatives from the local community.

While it would be an advantage for a local community representative to have a demonstrated understanding and experience in similar or related fields to the experts, this is not essential. The local community representatives will ensure that local insights and knowledge are provided to the Panel.

Members will be remunerated for attending panel meetings and panel meetings will typically be convened on a monthly basis.

The term of the engagement will be for a 3-year period with the option to extend this term by a further 3 years.
