We're welcoming the year of the dragon with a fun-filled afternoon and evening of activities featuring cultural performances, a high pole lion dance, a dragon dance, and the thrilling Excite Stunt Show, with a spectacular display of fireworks to close out the night.

The dragon is the most auspicious – and, in fact, the only fictitious – animal in the 12-year cycle of Chinese zodiac signs.

People born during the year of the dragon are said to be powerful, endlessly energetic, full of vitality, goal-oriented yet idealistic and romantic, and visionary leaders.

Lucky numbers for people born in the Year of the Dragon are 1, 6 and 7. Years of the Dragon include 1916, 1928, 1940, 1952, 1964, 1976, 1988, 2000, 2012, and 2024.
