5.2 Death of Richard Gill AO

- Councillor Gordon advised that he had provided the Mayor with the details
 of the death of Richard Gill and that as a result the Mayor had submitted a
 Mayoral Minute to Council
- Part of this minute resolved that the Arts Advisory Committee be consulted about a suitable commemorative activity by Council
- Many members of this committee also advised of their close connection with Mr Gill
- It was noted that Mr Gill had a great love for libraries
- Edna Wilde advised that the Ryde Eisteddfod will be honouring Mr Gill with a Youth Music Award to be named the Richard Gill Award.
- A number of suggestions were considered by the committee including support of a scholarship for a young composer to be given to a person of limited financial means.
- Another suggestion was for a plaque and/or artwork to be purchased for display in a library.
- It was suggested that an audio display of music be provided in conjunction with the artwork so visitors could listen to music whilst enjoying the art.

5.3 Update on the Arts and Culture position

- Angela Jones-Blayney advised that the selected candidate has advised they will not be accepting the role. The position will now be readvertised.

5.4 Update on Illuminatrope public art installation

- John Brown advised that following discussions with the artists that the sculpture has now been placed in Banjo Patterson Park.
- Three comments have been received from the public.
- Permanent placement of the sculpture will occur soon at which time a plaque and unveiling ceremony will be arranged.
- It was suggested that lighting be incorporated into the base supporting the sculpture to provide better visibility at night.
