Actions arising out of the previous minutes

(a) <u>Update on 10/50 Draft Vegetation Clearing Code</u> by NSW RFS

The Committee was advised that Council lodged a submission in respect of the above code. The closing date for submissions was 21st July 2014 and on 1st August 2014, the draft code became legislation.

Council has written to the relevant Ministers and local MP's asking that Council's submission be taken into consideration. Other Councils are also taking action and seeking either revocation of the legislation or that it only apply to areas outside the Sydney Metropolitan area.

Tatjana and Nicola will be attending a workshop on 22nd September where this issue will be further discussed.

NSROC will be meeting with RFS and have been vocal in trying to revoke or limit the impact of the legislation.

Some Council's are garnering community support through their websites.

It was noted that North Sydney has asked to be exempted, and a suggestion was made that perhaps Ryde could be exempted as well.

It was further noted that one town house was damaged in a previous bush fire but that there has been no other known damage to property from bush fires in the past.

(b) Biodiversity Plan project

Nicola thanked those people who had provided comment on the proposal to date. She advised that many of the comments have been included in the Biodiversity Plan – eg use of a student to assist with the project.

She noted that many comments were site specific and that this type of assessment would occur later in the process.

The Biodiversity Plan is designed to be a high level, strategic plan with city wide application.

The Consultant, when selected, will consult with this committee.

The Plan will not include specific site management plans for each location but will be broad and relate to all areas.

Tatjana to send the map showing the areas affected in City of Ryde to Councillors and committee members.

A formal map has not been provided by RFS, only a tool to find out if a particular property is affected.

Council approval is to be sought for a submission to be drafted for this committee to forward to the relevant groups. The submission will seek exemption for City of Ryde from the legislation.

An invitation is to be extended to various Bushcare and other groups offering to meet with them and explain what is intended by the new legislation.

It is intended to approach the local community groups and ask them to write to the local members and relevant Ministers to voice disagreement with this plan.

Council will be encouraged to support NSROC in any action it takes to revoke the legislation in metropolitan areas.

An update on this matter is to be provided to the next meeting of this committee.

In future, information is to be forwarded to the members of this committee prior to meetings, so that they can consult with the groups they represent prior to attending Bushland Advisory Committee meetings.

4. General Business

(a) Biodiversity Legislation Review Paper

The State Government forwarded a copy of the above paper to Council for comment.

With very few exceptions, an independent panel set up by the government will be reviewing all biodiversity legislation.

Committee members were forwarded a copy of the document but no feedback was provided and therefore no submission was made by Council to the Review Paper

(b) Bushcare arrangements for extended leave.

Sandra Payne has accepted a placement with the Australian Army for 6 months which will end in April 2015. She is therefore taking extended leave from Council.

In her absence, supervisors with appropriate experience will oversee Bushcare groups and in addition, two casual staff will be employed to undertake the work Sandra carries out with Bushcare groups.

Update from members of the Committee

Pressure on banks

It was noted that some environmental groups are seeking to place pressure on Australian banks to encourage them not to provide funding for projects such as the Carmichael Mine.
