**Council's Traffic Engineer – Traffic and Governance report 23 May 2012****Consultation**

A door knock survey was carried out with the affected businesses of seventeen (17) properties along Buffalo Road on 22 May 2012 for the concurrence of the proposed short term parking restrictions along Buffalo Road outside the businesses. Council has received mixed responses from the business owners. The results of the Survey are summarised in the table below:

**Some of the comments are as follows:**

- All business properties along Buffalo Road have on-street parking provided for customers
- If Council introduce any restrictions employees of businesses will park in nearby residential streets.
- Early morning smash repairer staff take up available parking spaces along Buffalo Road and surrounding streets.

**Council can adopt from following options.**

- Council introduce 1P parking in front of only four (4) properties (No.23, No.32, No.34 and No.21) along Buffalo Road. (There are existing 1P restrictions in front of No.56 and 1/2P restrictions outside take away shop No. 18)
- Council take no action to change existing parking restrictions along Buffalo Road
- Council request regulatory services to patrol Buffalo Road for illegal parking by unregistered vehicles.

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The next Ordinary Meeting of the Ryde Traffic Committee will be held on 26 July 2012.
