I was delighted to announce funding from Investing in Women NSW for a series of four women's empowerment activities at our recent *Secure, Independent and Ready for the Future* forum held on White Ribbon Day.

This grant of nearly \$20,000 for our Women's Empowerment Boot Camps Project means more activities for women of all ages, backgrounds and life stage like the recent STEM Careers Workshop with CSIRO and next year's Leadership forum and Small Business Workshops.

Council has been a strong advocate of White Ribbon Day since 2008 and promotes gender equality through policies and activities. We believe that promoting gender equality and advancing the social, economic and political status of women is an important way to help prevent violence against women.
