With Refugee Week having kicked off on Sunday, we will be hosting two inspiring speakers at Ryde Library over the next few days. On Thursday 21 June you can hear from author Robin de Crespigny as she discusses her award-winning book, *The People Smuggler: The true story of Ali Al Jenabi, the 'Oskar Schindler of Asia'*.

On Tuesday 26 June we will also be hosting young Iraqi woman Aya Mustafa. This passionate advocate and public speaker is giving a voice to young people from refugee backgrounds. Bookings are free for both events.
