### The New Heart of Ryde

The initial response to the City of Ryde's new vision for the Ryde Civic Centre site has been extremely encouraging.

Known as 'The New Heart of Ryde', Council's proposal maps out a new Ryde Civic Centre site that is focused on the community.

It will result in a four-fold increase in multipurpose community space with no residential development. Importantly, the project will be financially sustainable, will not increase rates or result in any cuts to any Council services.

Formal consultation on The New Heart of Ryde will begin on 26 June and run until 25 August.

I strongly encourage everyone to take part in this consultation as all feedback received during this period will help formulate the final report that will be submitted to Council for consideration later in the year.
