**City of Ryde COVID-19 update**

The coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic is having a serious impact on everyone in our community.

At the City of Ryde, we are taking a range of measures to ensure we can still support everyone during this extremely challenging period.

To date, we have:

- Endorsed new measures that will ensure Council operations will continue in the event that councillors cannot meet due to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Extended the lifting of curfews for supermarket delivery trucks until to help restock shelves. This extension applies to all supermarkets in the City of Ryde, and has since been implemented by the State Government across NSW
- Created a dedicated COVID-19 hub on the City of Ryde website, which includes important information such as relevant news, frequently asked questions, as well as updates on the status of Council services and events. - Moved our Building and Development Advisory Service to our phone service only
- Implemented a 'Drop and Collect' service model at Ryde Libraries which provides access for members to borrow and return as well as timed access to PC and printing services. It will also allow for new membership sign ups and JP services when available. Ryde Library Service's Online Library

also allows library members to access a wide range of eBooks and eAudiobooks.

Council's services have been impacted following directions from the Federal and State governments, but where we can we will continue to offer services to the community while adhering to strict hygiene and social distancing measures.
