Blenheim Park masterplan endorsed

Providing the City of Ryde with first-class parks, playgrounds and open spaces is a key priority of this Council.

That is why we have endorsed a new masterplan for Blenheim Park in North Ryde, which will result in the expansion of the park and a greater range of diverse and inclusive facilities installed.

Key features of the masterplan include new multi-use courts, a small skate park, a major upgrade to the existing playground and a new fenced dog off-leash area. A new radio control car track will also be installed along with new picnic areas, pathways and a biodiversity corridor.

The implementation of the masterplan will occur over a number of stages as funding becomes available. Funding for the first three stages has been identified in Council's Four Year Delivery Plan.

Ryde becomes first Council to adopt a resilience plan

The City of Ryde continues to lead the way with Council becoming the first in NSW to adopt a comprehensive resilience plan. As we approach another bushfire and storm season, the memories of last season are still in firmly in the forefront of all our minds. The sequence of events in 2019-2020 have forced us to cope with the extreme challenges now magnified by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and a long road of recovery that we will need to embark on collectively.

Our new Ryde Resilience Plan 2030 means we will be in a better position as a Council and a community to anticipate and prepare for these extremely difficult situations, while also reducing the severity and negative impacts on the community. The plan also aligns with the policies and initiatives that Council has committed to in recent years, including our declaration of a climate emergency, adoption of a 100 percent renewable energy target by 2030 and priorities and actions of the North District Plan established by the Greater Sydney Commission.
