Have Your Say on the future of our open spaces

I may be biased, but I think the City of Ryde has some of the best open spaces and recreation facilities in Sydney.

But to ensure this remains the case, Council must continually plan for the future to ensure our open spaces meet the needs of our community.

Based on current participation rates and population projections, we will need an additional 135 hectares of open spaces, 12 additional indoor courts and 13 additional full-size ovals (or equivalent) by 2036.

To help us achieve this, we are now asking the community for their

opinions to help shape Council's Open Space Future Provision Strategy.

Bus route changes

I have been contacted by a lot of residents who have been severely impacted by the latest cancellations and changes to local bus routes by Transport for NSW.

Many residents who live in the City of Ryde must already contend with bus services which are infrequent and do not go close to their homes. The latest changes to local bus routes will exacerbate these issues.

Of particular concern is the way these changes were made without adequate consultation with the community or Council.

I would encourage you to write to Transport Minister Andrew Constance and request a full review of the changes and re-instatement of the bus routes that have been cut.

Under the changes, routes M52, 520, X15, X18 and X06 have been withdrawn, while changes have been made to routes 515, 518 and 525.

This event is presented with the support of NSW Public Libraries Association.


