EV CHARGERS

The City of Ryde is committed to helping residents make the transition to more sustainable modes of transport.

As part of this commitment, Council has installed two Electric Vehicle (EV) charging spaces at the new Rowe Street East Car Park in Eastwood, which are now operational.

EV owners can presently charge their car for two hours free of charge at the car park by downloading the Exploren App via the App Store or Google Play, signing up and scanning the QR code at the charging station.
