GRANNY SMITH FESTIVAL PROGRAM OUT NOW

The 2022 Granny Smith Festival program is out now! Taking place on Saturday 15 October from 9.00am - 8.30pm in Eastwood town centre, there's truly something for everyone this year.

Kicking off with the famous Grand Street Parade, there'll also be over 250 market stalls and food trucks, along with the Batlow Cider Bar on Eastwood Oval.

Highlights for kids and young people located in Eastwood Public School include The Core Youth Zone with a pop-up skate park, dance workshops and battles, Mario Kart Tournament, drama workshops and graffiti art, as well as live acoustic sets across the day.

Also located in the school grounds is a free Circus Playground with side show alley games and free face painting.

Down at Eastwood Oval there'll be carnival rides, an animal farm, and live shows by Paw Patrol.

There's an impressive entertainment line-up this year, with a singing competition and performances across 5 stages.

The Festival will finish with a bang, with headliner Dami Im leading us in for a fireworks finale.
