As Mayor in 2016, I had the privilege of meeting many outstanding people from our community. One of those was Erik Horrie, our then Australia Day Ambassador.

Erik grew up in the foster care system and became a paraplegic at the age of 21 following a car accident. These experiences made Erik determined to seize every opportunity. As a world class Paralympian rower, he won silver medals at the London and Rio Paralympic Games. Just last month, Erik was crowned World Champion in the PR1 Men's Single Scull and set a new World Record.

These are some of the reasons I was so delighted to welcome Erik Horrie back to Ryde as guest speaker at a Social Inclusion event.

Erik also works closely with the Ryde Rehabilitation Centre and is an outstanding role model and inspiration for all.
