Proposed Classification of Land

Council is to acquire the land known as:

Pursuant to Section 34 of the Local Government Act 1993, Council proposes to make the following resolution with respect to the Land:

- (a) That pursuant to Section 31 (2) the land known as 101/3 and 105/3 and 510/3 Mooltan Avenue Macquarie Park (previously known as 110 – 114 Herring Road Macquarie Park) being Lots 1 and 157 and 29 respectively in SP 93581 be classified as operational land.

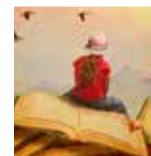
