#### **New Wildlife Protection Areas**

New Wildlife Protection Areas are now in effect at three bushland corridors in the City of Ryde to help better protect our unique native wildlife.

Field of Mars Reserve has been declared as a Category 1 Wildlife Protection Area, meaning dogs and cats are not allowed

Meanwhile, bushland reserves along Kittys Creek and Terrys Creek have been declared as Category 2 Wildlife Protection Areas, which allows dogs on-leash along established tracks, but does not permit cats.

This decision by the City of Ryde follows community consultation which found that there was overwhelming support for the declaration of Wildlife Protection Areas at the three locations.
