No smoking trial at Rowe Street East

Smoking will be prohibited in Rowe Street East, Eastwood, as part of a six-month trial being undertaken by the City of Ryde.

The trial follows the success of similar trials at Eastwood Plaza and West Ryde Plaza, both of which are now permanent Smoke Free Zones.

As part of the trial, No Smoking Signs will be displayed along the street to alert the community to the Smoke Free Zone being trialled. All existing cigarette butt bins will also be removed and information cards will be distributed throughout the area to raise awareness of the trial.

The trial will run from 1 March to 31 August. Following its completion, a report will be prepared for Council's consideration.

PUTNEY PARK BEACH ACTIVATION

The City of Ryde is seeking feedback on a proposal to construct sandstone steps at Putney Park to activate the foreshore and provide the community with access to the existing beach area.

In October 2019, Council endorsed the Parramatta River Masterplan which sets out to make Parramatta River swimmable again by 2025. Through extensive community consultation and endorsement from Council, Putney Park was chosen as one of three potential future swimming sites.

To deliver on this plan, Council is proposing the construction of steps to enhance the amenity of the park, provide new recreation opportunities for the community and progress towards future swimmability of the site by 2025.
