



Plaque unveiled to commemorate General Sir John Monash

It was a pleasure to join some of my fellow councillors and members of the local community to unveil a new plaque commemorating General Sir John Monash at Gladesville's Monash Park.

General Sir John Monash is viewed as one of Australia's most accomplished senior commanders of the First World War, in which he led troops at Gallipoli and the Western Front. Upon his return to Australia he dedicated his professional life to leading civic roles and was even a founding member of Australia's first Rotary club.

Given Sir Monash's significant role in Australia's history, it is fitting that the City of Ryde can commemorate his achievements through this new plaque.

For those who want to see the new plaque for themselves, it is located in the park's recently upgraded Monash Grandstand.

Rates relief for Ryde

Last week, I detailed aspects of the 2020/21 Council Budget which is all about supporting the community through the COVID-19 pandemic and helping Ryde get back on the road to recovery.

A key part of this budget is the introduction of rates related financial hardship provisions. This means approved Jobseeker and Jobkeeper applicants may defer rates payments until the end of September and are also eligible for a \$400 council rates rebate.

All eligible pensioners will also receive a \$150 voluntary pensioner subsidy to supplement the \$250 statutory pensioner subsidy they already receive.

All other ratepayers will have access to rates relief via a mutually acceptable Rates Payment Plan.

It is all part of Council's commitment to provide support to those who need it most during this pandemic.

Swimming lessons return to the RALC

Swimming lessons will resume at the Ryde Aquatic Leisure Centre (RALC) from next Monday (20 July) in accordance with current COVID-19 restrictions.

NSW Planning Portal

There are changes to the way customers are required to lodge their development applications within the City of Ryde, with all applications now to be done through the NSW Planning Portal.


Customers will need to register with the Planning Portal website and then submit their application via the portal. Council will then review the application for acceptance, with customers also able to track the progress of their application via the Planning Portal.

This change means Council will no longer be able to accept physical applications by post or in person.

I would like to thank staff from the City of Ryde and the NSW Government for all their work in transitioning to the NSW Planning Portal. It is a good example of collaboration between both levels of government.
