Councils can help with vaccine rollout

The serious risk COVID-19 poses to everyone's health and safety means it is imperative that everyone in the Ryde community gets vaccinated as soon as possible.

To assist with this, I have written multiple times to NSW Health Minister Brad Hazzard asking him to partner with local government and open up walk-in vaccination hubs across the state. Incredibly I am yet to receive a response.

Councils like the City of Ryde administer thousands of other vaccines all year round and have facilities currently sitting empty that could house vaccination hubs.

Such hubs would also help our community reach 80 percent vaccination coverage quicker and ensure lockdowns become a thing of the past.

I will keep writing to Mr Hazzard until the City of Ryde has its own NSW Health walk-in vaccination hub.
