Ryde Aquatic Leisure Centre reopens

After weeks of campaigning, it was great to get a win with the NSW Government agreeing to bring forward the reopening of indoor pools such as the Ryde Aquatic Leisure Centre (RALC).

During the extensive Greater Sydney lockdown, we were continually bombarded with images of thousands of eastern suburbs residents cramming Bondi Beach, while residents in the City of Ryde had no access to public pools.

Thanks to the NSW Government's rethink, the RALC is now open for training, lap swimming and rehab activities, with swimming lessons to resume on Monday 18 October.

Libraries and Customer Service

The easing of COVID-19 restrictions also means the Customer Service Centre and Ryde Library branch are now also open to members of the public.

Both are currently open Monday to Friday between 10.00am and 4.00pm.

At this stage it is planned for Ryde, Eastwood, Gladesville and West Ryde library branches to all reopen and resume normal hours of operation from Monday 25 October.

North Ryde Library will remain closed while work on the Coxs Road Town Centre upgrade continues.

Conditions of entry

In line with the NSW Government's directions, the following rules apply to all Council venues at the current time:

- Visitors 16 years and over must be fully vaccinated or have a medical exemption. Proof of vaccination status will be required
- Visitors will be required to check-in when visiting either by using the Service NSW smartphone app or manually lodging their details
- Visitors at any indoor Council venue who is aged 12 or over will be required to wear a face mask at all times (unless exempt) and abide by the four-square metre rule.

Macquarie Park bus interchange

If you have not done so already, I would encourage you to view Council's proposal for a pedestrian-only public plaza to be built in Macquarie Park, and voice your support.

The proposal, which is part of a promise from the Federal and State Government for a new bus interchange, in Macquarie Park, has unfortunately been ignored by Transport for NSW which wants to progress with plans that amount to nothing more than a fancy bus stop, with 'bus only' lanes installed and no public plaza.
