

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

WHAT CAN THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SUBSIDY COVER?

- Contribution to travel costs to attend the NSW Youth Council Conference
- Contribution to accommodation costs to attend the NSW Youth Council Conference.

HOW DO I CLAIM?

- You must first put in an application. All applications must be received by August 18th 2017. Late applications may not be considered
- A decision will be made based on the eligibility of your claim (see below). You will be informed by Friday 1st September of the outcome – including approved funding amount
- To receive the funding, City of Ryde will require confirmation that you have paid for transport / accommodation and an invoice made out to City of Ryde
- Subsidies are capped at \$400 per person with a maximum of 4 people eligible from any community / LGA – please see the table below

Distance Travelled	Max Subsidy Available
0-100 km	\$100 per head
100-250km	\$200 per head
250km+	\$400 per head

- The committee will consider applications that do not fully meet the eligibility criteria if financial hardship is a factor.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a Council or NGO with a youth council or youth advisory group
- Must be based in NSW and all people benefitting from the Financial Assistance package must be residents of NSW
- Must have a commitment to attend every aspect of the 2017 NSW Youth Council Conference.

GUIDELINES

- The distribution of these finite funds is at the discretion of the 2017 NSW YCC committee and their decision is final
- If the fund is oversubscribed, preference will be given to those experiencing from Financial Hardship and people from Rural and Regional NSW.
