CITY OF RYDE PAYS TRIBUTE TO QUEEN ELIZABETH II

City of Ryde wishes to pay tribute to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, who passed away on 8 September 2022 following a reign of more than 70 years.

In honour of Her Majesty, the Australian flag will fly at half-mast at locations around the City of Ryde until the day after her funeral.
