At the full meeting of Council on Tuesday 13 September, Councillor Artin Etmekdjian was re-elected as Mayor of the City of Ryde for a 12 month term. Councillor Gabrielle O'Donnell was elected Deputy Mayor.

Clr Etmekdjian thanked his fellow Councillors for their support. "It is an honour to accept the role of Mayor of the City of Ryde for a second term.

"The past 12 months have been both challenging and rewarding and I am excited by the prospects ahead.
