City of Ryde Works Update

Did you know?

The City of Ryde annually constructs or maintains:

- 17.75km of cycleways
- 250km of drainage
- 310km of roads
- 402km of footpaths.

With such a huge amount of infrastructure to maintain, the Council's construction and maintenance program is carefully planned using an asset management system. Here is a summary of some recent works undertaken in our City.

Footpath Program

Between September and October, new and replacement footpaths were completed at:

- Bennett Street, West Ryde (south side)
- Pittwater Road, East Ryde (from Coxs Road to Bronhill Avenue)
- Waterloo Road, Macquarie Park (from No 21 to Eden Park Drive)
- Wandoo Ave, Ryde (from No 16 to Gladstone Avenue)
- Longview Street, Eastwood (kerb ramps)
- Adelaide Street, West Ryde (No.78 to Meadowbank Lane)
- Douglas Street, Putney (kerb ramps at Cleeves Park)
- Tallwood Avenue, Ryde (kerb ramp, cnr North Rd)

Roads

The annual roads program ensures that the road infrastructure such as asphalt pavement, kerbs and gutters are upgraded and maintained as required.

Works have recently been completed at:

- Abuklea Road, Eastwood (between Kingsford Avenue and Wilga Place)
- Buffalo Road, Ryde (between Providence and Aitchandar Road)
- Coxs Road, North Ryde (between Cressy Road and Harford Street)
- Coxs Road, North Ryde (between Blenheim Road and Badajoz Road)
- Hermitage Road, West Ryde (between Parkes Street and Wattle Street)
- Khartoum Road, Macquarie Park (between Talavera Road and Waterloo Road)
- Wicks Road, North Ryde (between Waterloo Road – Pittwater Road)
