PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE

The City of Ryde allocates around \$10million annually to the ongoing maintenance and construction of public infrastructure including roads, footpaths, walkways, cycleways and drainage system. Here is an update of current works:

Meadowbank

The park upgrade involving construction of a seawall near Helene Park at Charity Point is complete. No shared user path was part of this work however the seawall was constructed adjacent to the existing shared use path.

Northern Districts

All footpaths listed have been constructed and are complete.

Epping Road shared use path from Lyon Park Road to pedestrian overbridge – complete.

Waterloo Road shared use path from Macquarie University to Lane Cove Road –complete.

Solar panels and building upgrade to Ryde Park café – complete.

Gladesville

Pending road resurfacing on Monash Road will occur once the Sydney Water pipe upgrade is complete in late 2012.

Upcoming works

Ryde

Park upgrade at Charity Creek Casades awaiting service adjustment by Telstra and will be open in mid August 12. Shared user path and earthworks complete.

North Ryde

Pittwater Road upgrade, from Carramar Avenue to Coxs Road. Road widening, new kerb and gutter, drainage and shared user path. Works underway, finish date end August.

Next stage to commence in Sept 2012 from Coxs Road to Bronhill Avenue.

North Ryde

New footpath on Brendon Street, North Ryde (Cave Avenue – Bridge Road) East side Starting August 2012.

West Ryde

New footpath on Adelaide Street, West Ryde (No. 82 to Meadowbank Park) East side Starting August 2012.
