Capital Works Update November 2012 – February 2013

Road resurfacing / Kerb renewal

The annual road program ensures that the road infrastructure such as asphalt pavement, kerb and gutter is upgraded as required and maintained to an acceptable level. Selection of roads is on a priority basis.

Footpaths

Traffic Facilities

Traffic facilities are devices built in the road reserve to slow traffic and improve safety for drivers and pedestrians. They include flat top road humps, pedestrian refuges and traffic islands

Complete works (Nov 2012-Jan 2013)

- Flat Top Road Hump, Chatham Road, West Ryde (Fernvale Avenue)
- Traffic Island, Chatham Road, West Ryde (Buena Vista Avenue)
- Traffic Island, Miriam Road / West Parade, West Ryde
- Traffic Island, Morrison Road, Ryde
- Flat Top Road Hump, Twin Road, East Ryde
- Traffic Island, Badajoz Road, North Ryde (Twin Road – Nerang Street)

Pending works (Feb 2013)

Sportsfield Renewals and Upgrades

Sportsfields identified as high priority in Council's asset register are scheduled for renewal works which include regrading and levelling of the playing surfaces, installation of automatic irrigation systems and subsoil drainage

Pending works

- Eastwood Park Croquet Club (renewal of croquet greens) – Works continuing
- Marsfield Park – Works continuing
- ELS Hall Park – Works to commence January 2013
- Meadowbank Netball Courts – Netball courts to be completed in March 2013 in readiness for the 5 April 2013 State Championships.

Sportsfield Flood Lighting

Sport field lighting has been identified as a priority to extend the use of existing sport fields for night training and matches.

Pending Works

- Waterloo Park – Development Application preparation currently in progress
- Magdala Park – Contractor to be appointed

Toilet Upgrades

Toilet upgrades are undertaken on outdated parks to meet the needs of user of the facility & to improve the building ventilation and security. The parks are utilised through summer and winter by local sporting groups on a regular basis as well as a number of casual users.

Pending Works

- Fontenoy Park – Project due for completion December 2012.
- Tuckwell Park – Planned to review scope of works on completion of Fontenoy Park. Scope of works is dependant on available funds.
- Santa Rosa Park – Scoping is nearing completion
- ELS Hall Park – Scope is under review with key stakeholders

Park Upgrades

Pending works (Jan – Feb 2013)

- Livvi's Place Yamble Reserve Inclusive Playground - design and construct a playground which allows play between children of all abilities. In partnership with the Touched By Olivia Foundation. Car park works commenced January 2013. Official opening 3 February 2013.
- Queens Jubilee Trees - Commemorative planting of trees recognise the 60 Year Jubilee Celebrations of the reign of Queen Elizabeth II along the Ryde Riverside Reserve from Meadowbank Park to Kissing Point Park. Planting and staking works are underway.
