Set on New Year's Eve of December 2029, a news anchor is ending the nightly bulletin with a look back at the decade 'that could be'; a decade that saw Australia transition to a fairer, cleaner, more community focused economy.

	Schools will receive a digital copy of the film and are also invited to download a free School Action Toolkit. School screenings can commence from mid-April in VIC/NSW and from mid-May in all other states and territories.
