

City of Ryde “Library Information Week Hamper Competition” – Terms and Conditions

How to Enter

The City of Ryde “Library Information Week Hamper Competition” Promotion commences at 10:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on Friday 17 May 2019 and closes at 11.59pm AEDT on Sunday, 26 May 2019.

The following terms and conditions apply:

1. The Promoter is City of Ryde Library Service of 1 Pope Street, Ryde NSW 2112.
2. Employees, Contractors and Councillors of the Promoter are not eligible to enter.
3. Entry is open to NSW residents with a valid City of Ryde library membership only.
4. Children 17 years or under require parental consent.
5. Library membership is free. Valid identification is required.
6. Only one entry per person is permitted
