ART TO INSPIRE WOMEN OF THE FUTURE International Women's Day Competition/Exhibition

International Women's Day 2012 will be celebrated this year with an exhibition of locally inspired art at Brush Farm House, 8 – 10 March. The exhibition invites entries in all art forms which reflect this year's local International Women's theme promoting the 'Resilience and Empowerment' of women.

Sponsored by the City of Ryde as an initiative of the Status of Women Advisory Committee, the theme focuses on improving the economic, social and political lives of women of the future by enhancing the choices for the girls of today.

The Council's Manager Community and Culture, Baharak Sahebekhtiari said: "Just as this worldwide event celebrates women's contribution to society, our exhibition will provide local artists with a unique opportunity to showcase their creativity and vision for women, through painting, sculpture, photography and multi-media."
