OPEN DOOR TO COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

The City of Ryde will hold the first in a series of informal Community Council Meetings at the North Ryde School of Arts Community Hall (201 Coxs Road) on Tuesday 30 April, starting at 7.30pm.

Acknowledging the return to a more community-friendly Council, City of Ryde Mayor, Cllr Ivan Petch said: "Holding Council Meetings in local Wards makes it much more convenient for members of the community to drop by and also to have a say on issues that are relevant to their neighbourhood.

"The meeting format will be less formal than those held in the Council Chamber and the agenda will include an overview of projects being delivered to the area as outlined in the City of Ryde Delivery Plan."

There is no need to advise in advance if you wish to attend the Community Council Meeting. However, if you wish to speak at the Meeting, you will need to register by filling in a Request to Address form that can be downloaded from www.ryde.nsw.gov.au/addresscouncil

The agenda will be available on the City of Ryde website and at all library branches from Thursday 18 April.

Throughout 2013 Community Council Meetings will be held in each of the three Council Wards (East, Central and West) and the agenda for each will focus on issues relevant to that Ward.
