IMPROVE YOUR PROSPECTS AT RYDE JOBS AND SKILLS EXPO

The Ryde Jobs and Skills Expo is coming to the Ryde Civic Centre on Wednesday 6 November to connect job seekers with local employment and training opportunities.

The Expo is the first of its kind in the Ryde area providing a one-stop-shop where job seekers can speak face-to-face with skill providers and job service agencies. A jobs board will list current positions vacant and job seekers will be able to register for free workshops on the day on:

- How to write a good resume
- Proven job searching techniques
- Perfecting your interview skills

Information will also be provided on traineeships, migrant programs, and other government funded incentives for skills development.

The Expo is also a chance for local small business operators to find and develop the right staff with the right skills for their business.

A highlight of the program will be a panel discussion with leading education and skill providers. Chair of the panel, Dr June Heinrich, CEO of Macquarie Community College, said: "This event brings together all of our local training organisations and job service agencies under one roof. It's an event that job seekers cannot afford to miss."

Also on the discussion panel will be Karl King of Northern Sydney Institute of TAFE, Lynn Mann of Salvation Army Employment Plus, and City of Ryde's Economic Development Manager.
