Russell is a dedicated hands-on volunteer whose tireless work provides adults and children with intellectual disabilities the chance to lead a life 'more extraordinary'.

He is particularly keen in introducing them to a range of sporting and outdoor activities and enjoys seeing the ten pin bowling and bocce teams that he coaches enjoy the positive benefits of competitive sport. He also drives his teams to sporting competitions, supervising, encouraging and supporting their needs. Another of his commitments is to go on overnight camping excursions (usually 1-4 days) for the Challenge Foundation's Orphans Trust Fund which provides experiences for people with a disability to enjoy the freedom and adventure that many of us take for granted.

Through his generous giving, Russell touches the lives of people who need support and his work reminds us of the importance of volunteering.

Carla Kassab

An active member of the Ryde Youth Council since 2010, Carla Kassab plays an important role in mentoring, representing and advocating for local young people.

Her dedication to serving the community is coupled with a can-do attitude and an ability to multi-task that takes her from volunteering and fundraising, to event planning and student counselling.

As a member of the Northern Sydney Youth Health Promotion team for NSW Health, Carla helps promote good health and well-being to local young people, with a focus on lifestyle issues related to smoking, alcohol, emotional and social issues, and obesity.

Carla is a positive role model for young women in Ryde who has turned her own experiences into a powerful and driving passion to help others.

Carla has committed hundreds of hours to community organisations including our local Rotary's Gift Wrapping project for the past two Christmases, and has held off going to University to fulfil her community commitments.
