Whether you are reading to your child or your child is reading for their own pleasure it is now easier than ever to borrow books online thanks to Ryde Library's new eBook and eAudiobook collection for children aged 0 – 12 years.

With over 1,200 children's fiction, beginner readers, picture books and non-fiction titles in the online collection borrowing is just a click away.

All you or your child needs is a current Ryde Library Membership number and PIN, a compatible device with an internet connection and the relevant software or app installed on your device. If you are a resident, worker or student in the City of Ryde or the Hunters Hill area, you can borrow from the convenience of your home, the office, school, while travelling - anywhere at all.

City of Ryde Children's and Youth Librarian, Gabbi Wyllie said: "Parents are by far the most important educators in a child's life and it's never too young for a child to start to read. There's also ample evidence to suggest that children who read do better at school."

Reading is good for all of us because it:

- exercises our brains and improves concentration
- teaches children about the world and people around them
- improves a child's vocabulary
- develops a child's imagination
- is a great form of FREE entertainment.

About eBooks and eAudiobooks:

- Borrow up to 10 items.
- Maximum loan period is 21 days, but you can select a shorter loan period of 7 or 14 days.
- Loan limits for the Online Library collection are separate to the loan limit for other collections.
- At the end of the loan period files automatically expire on a user's computer or device and do not need to be returned. Because of this, there will be NO OVERDUES.
- eBooks can be returned early using the relevant app.
- Renewals are available.
