GLADESVILLE LIBRARY JOINT AGREEMENT SIGNED & SEALED

A new three-year Joint Library Agreement for Gladesville Library has been signed by City of Ryde and Hunters Hill Councils.

The Agreement ensures the continuation of high quality services for the community now and into the future and is another chapter in the nearly 60-year library services partnership between the two Councils.

Mayor for the City of Ryde, CIr Bill Pickering, said: "This agreement is the result of a collaborative effort between our two Councils for the benefit of the community. It strengthens a long-standing partnership and demonstrates the positive outcomes of sharing services, facilities and common goals for the benefit of the community.

Mayor of Hunters Hill, Clr Richard Quinn, added: "Libraries are more than places of reading and borrowing; they are important community hubs offering a huge range of services for all members of the community.

"This agreement is mutually beneficial to all and ensures the continuation of a great library service for local families."

The Agreement sets out the City of Ryde's responsibility for strategic, operational management of the library service and assets and Hunters Hill Council's commitment to a three year funding arrangement.
