TRAMPOLINES ADD EXTRA BOUNCE AT MONASH PARK

Kids are jumping for joy thanks to the new in-ground trampolines at the Monash Park playground.

The compact trampolines are part of a \$142,000 upgrade that has seen the playground double in size.

New play equipment includes swings, a slide and climbing structure, a spring jeep and spring motorbike added.

A brightly coloured fence encloses the playground and purple and orange spotted soft- fall covering surrounds the new equipment that is providing plenty of dynamic and energetic play for 0 – 12 year olds.

Well defined pathways for prams and wheelchairs, seating and amenities, provide safe, accessible and high quality facilities for children to play freely and for families to enjoy.

Tree-lined Monash Park located on Ryde Road, Gladesville, is one of our most popular neighbourhood parks, with a picket-fenced sportsfield, grandstand, public toilets, small garden with memorial and historic headstone.
