Princes Street (Buffalo Rd. to Blaxland Rd.), Ryde

Dear Resident

The City of Ryde is committed to deliver safer road infrastructure for the Ryde community under Council's Connected and Accessible City program.

In early 2019, Council consulted the community regarding the proposed works which at the time included proposed parking, removal of the median islands and realignment of the roadway. Following your subsequent feedback the design has been amended to retain the existing road layout on Princes Street between Buffalo and Blaxland.

It is now time to construct the works which will involve the reconstruction of kerb and gutter, driveway laybacks, construction of new stormwater pipes and pits and reinstatement of affected surfaces. This will be followed by road resurfacing. (see map on reverse side).

Timing of Works

Start of construction

Construction is anticipated to start in **early May 2020**.

Completion of construction

Construction is anticipated to be completed by **late December 2020**, weather permitting.

Construction hours are typically Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 4:00pm, and some Saturdays.

Changed Conditions

To allow the works to proceed safely, there will be traffic control in place to assist with access and manage traffic throughout the project works.
