Stormwater Drainage Upgrade and Road Closure Vimiera Road and Abuklea Road, Eastwood/Marsfield-

Re-commencement of Works

Dear resident or business operator

The City of Ryde has recently undertaken stormwater drainage works in Vimiera Road and Abuklea Road as part of Council's four year delivery plan for new infrastructure.

These works were carried out from Oct 2019 – Dec 2019, with the intention to recommence works onsite at the end of January 2020.

The project includes the installation of new drainage pits and pipes and reinstatement of affected surfaces. The works will be recommencing at the intersection of Vimiera Road and Abuklea Road. (see map on reverse side).

These works are part of a multi-stage plan and further works are anticipated in 2020/2021.

Road closures and changed traffic conditions

To allow the works to proceed safely there will be road closures in Vimiera Road and Abuklea Road. Detours will be in place to notify pedestrians, cyclists and drivers. A schedule of anticipated closures is provided in the table on the reverse side. In addition, temporary facilities will occupy the lower end of Abuklea Road for the duration of works. Access will be maintained wherever possible and residents will be advised of alternate access or parking arrangements in advance.

Timing of works

Construction is expected to recommence in late **January 2020**, and be completed by **April 2020**, weather permitting.

Construction hours are typically Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 4:00pm, and some Saturdays.

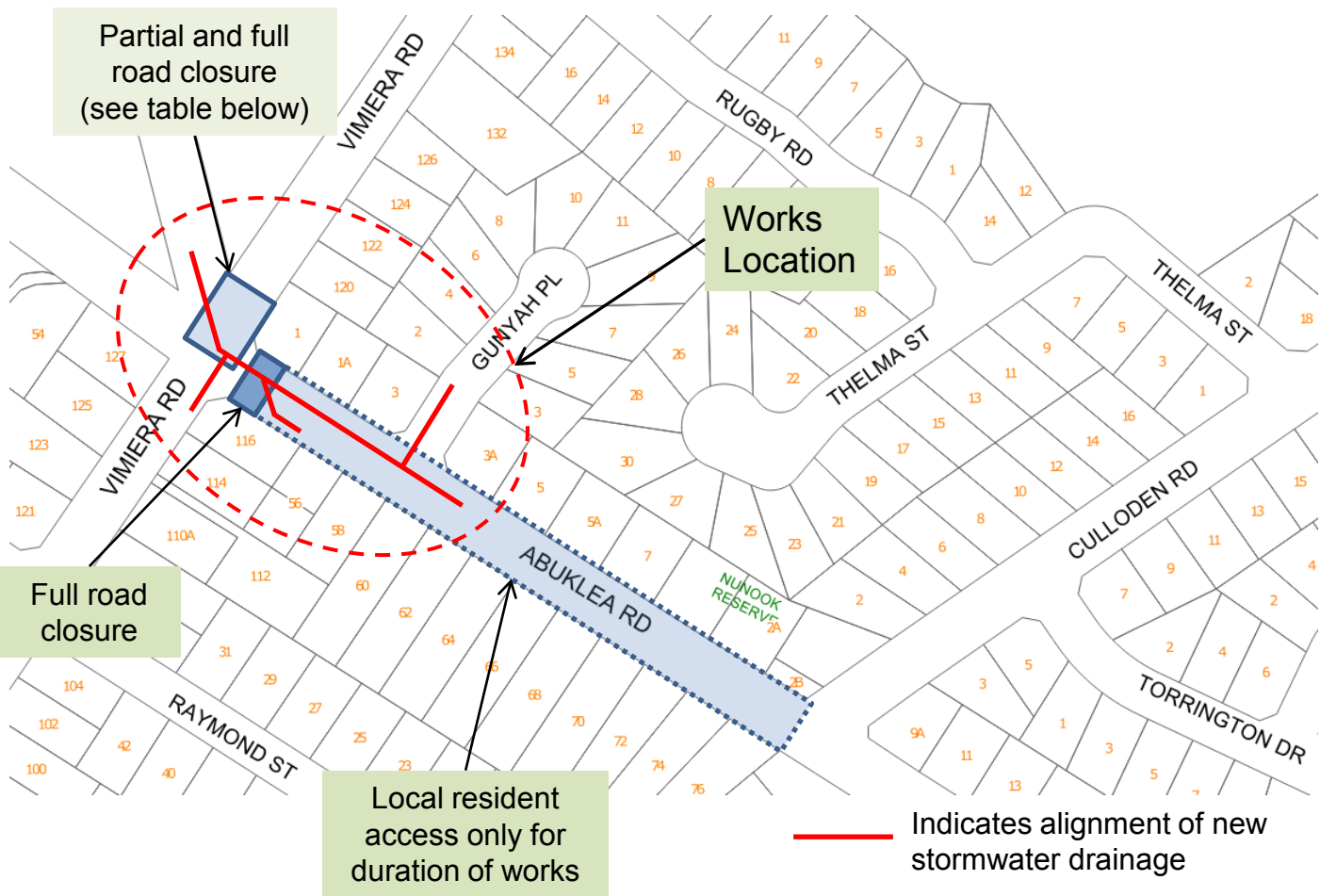
