We would like to inform you of the upcoming construction works to be undertaken at the intersection of Wicks Road and Coxs Road.

As part of the City of Ryde's ongoing commitment to pedestrian safety, new pedestrian fencing will be installed at the four corners of the busy intersection.

There will be some noise, vibration and disruption while the works are happening.

Machinery and equipment used may include truck, light vehicles, concrete core drill and hand tools.

Timing Of Works

Start of construction

Construction is expected to start on the **7th September 2020**.

Completion of construction

Construction is expected to be completed by the **11th September 2020**, weather permitting.

Changed Conditions

The majority of works will be carried out at night between **9:00pm to 5:00am**.

This is to minimise impact on motorists and to provide a safe work zone for the workers. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night.

Street accessibility and traffic will be altered during work hours. In the case where access to your property will be affected, you will be contacted by Council's contractor, Metal Fencing Specialists.
