

Pittwater Road Upgrade

(Western side - High Street to Rene Street)

Dear resident or business operator

The City of Ryde is committed to the delivery of high quality infrastructure and facilities. As part of this commitment, there will be road, footpath and drainage works on Pittwater Road (western side from High St to Rene St) to facilitate a new 2.5m wide Shared User Cycle Way. The full extent of the works include-

- Construction of kerb and gutter and upgrading of the stormwater network on the western side of Pittwater Rd from High Street to No.214
- Construction of a 2.5m wide concrete Shared User Cycleway on western side from High St to Rene St, which includes some embankment stabilisation works.
- Relocation of 8 Ausgrid power poles and overhead assets;

Changed traffic conditions

To allow the works to proceed safely there will restrictions imposed by Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) for hours of construction. Generally the works will be carried out during set times during the day (10:30am and 2.30pm), however there will be some periods where night works will be carried out (9:00pm to 5:00am). The contractor will provide prior notification in regard to vehicular crossing impacts and changing site and traffic conditions during the works.

Start of construction

Construction is expected to commence in mid January 2020.

Completion of construction

Construction is expected to be completed by end of June 2020, weather permitting.
