WORKS NOTIFICATION | FOOTPATH EXPANSION

Arthur Street, Ryde

The City of Ryde is committed to ensuring that the community has safe and accessible footpath links in their neighbourhood. As part of our Footpath Expansion Program, we will be constructing a footpath in the cul-de-sac end of Arthur Street, Ryde from 36 Arthur Street to the Bus Stop on Lane Cove Road.

What will the works involve?

The footpath works will include a new accessible footpath link along this section of Arthur Street, with new graded ramps and full accessibility to the Bus Stop on Lane Cove Road.

Preliminary works involve the removal of several small trees and vegetation along the design route of the new footpath link. Replacement trees and landscaping is included in the proposed completion works.

A location plan has been included on the back of this flyer.

When will the works take place?

Tree removal works are due to start in the week beginning **21 August 2023** with the footpath construction and landscaping works commencing in the week beginning **11 September 2023**, for three to four weeks, weather permitting.

Construction hours are typically Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 4:00pm.

What are the changed conditions during construction?

Existing pedestrian access to the Bus Stop may be altered for only short periods of time and access will be maintained to local properties.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.
