WORKS NOTIFICATION | ROAD RENEWAL WORKS

Taylor Avenue, Melrose Park (Between Cobham Avenue and Wharf Road)

The City of Ryde recently notified you regarding upcoming road kerb renewal works on Taylor Avenue, Melrose Park (Between Cobham Avenue and Wharf Road). These works are identified as part of Council's 2022/2023 Delivery Program to improve road safety and stormwater drainage.

We are writing to advise that these works are due to commence.

What will the works involve?

- Reconstruction of kerb and gutter within bus zones
- Removal of gutter bridges and reconstruction of affected driveways to suit new kerb alignment
- Renewal of stormwater drainage pits and pipes
- Road resurfacing and line-marking

A location plan has been included on the back of this flyer and a copy of the design plans can be viewed by scanning the QR code below.

When will the works take place?

Works will commence **Late October 2022** and are anticipated to be completed by **December 2022**, weather permitting.

The works will be carried out Monday to Friday and some Saturdays between the hours of 7.00am and 5.00pm. Every effort will be made to minimise inconvenience to residents during the construction period.

Will these works include changes to parking?

These works will not impact access to street parking or to current residential/ business parking lots. However, during construction the site supervisor will coordinate directly with individuals/ businesses impacted by the temporary lane/ driveway closures. The closure will be for a brief period and implemented in stages.
