MEADOWBANK EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT PRECINCT

The Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct has begun operating this week with classes commencing for Meadowbank Public and Marsden High Schools.

The new precinct is a big win for the City of Ryde as it has created a centre of excellence for education and lifelong learning, connecting students to training and employment opportunities right here on our doorstep.

But it will also result in a series of changes in the vicinity of the precinct that residents and businesses will need to be aware of, including a new 40 kilometre/hour school zone, new parking restrictions and new bus routes.

As a result, there may be more traffic during drop-off and pick-up times and more pedestrians in the area. This means motorists and pedestrians may need to consider changing their usual route if travelling within the precinct during peak times.
