BOOK LOCKER LAUNCHED AT GLADESVILLE LIBRARY

City of Ryde Libraries has launched a new book locker service at Gladesville Library, which will allow library members from across the City of Ryde to pick up their reserved items 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

To use the new service, library members simply have to reserve their items online, choose Book Locker – Gladesville as their pick-up location and then use their mobile phone to pick up their items at a time that suits them.

The book locker also has accessible compartments and is conveniently located near the Gladesville Library car park.

REFUGEE WEEK


The City of Ryde is staging a number of events this week as part of Refugee Week, which aims to celebrate the positive contributions made by refugees to Australian society.

2022 Sustainable Waste 2 Art Prize

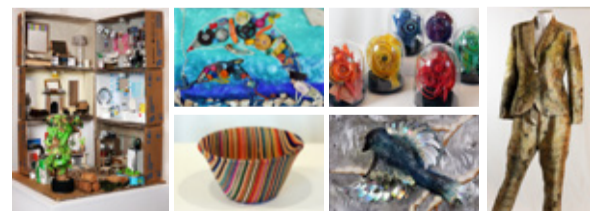
