Progress has been made on a new multi-sports facility at the former Marsden High School site in West Ryde.

A planning proposal seeking to rezone the site has been submitted to the Department of Planning and Environment.

Under the plans, the existing 28 netball courts at Meadowbank will be relocated to the former Marsden High School site to create 32 new outdoor netball courts, as well as a state-of-the-art indoor facility comprising four multi-use courts.

Crucially, the planning proposal also creates a new environmental conservation zone on a section of the former high school site, which will protect precious blue gums and a critically endangered ecological community.

In addition, a report will be brought back to Council detailing a list of measures that address community concerns relating to parking, traffic and noise abatement.

Once completed, the new facility will be the new home of the Eastwood Ryde Netball Association and utilised by several other local sporting groups as well.
