SOLAR-POWERED BINS

During a recent visit to Meadowbank Park, Councillor Sophie Lara-Watson and I were shown the inner workings of the new solar-powered waste bin that has been installed as part of a litter reduction trial being undertaken by City of Ryde. Another bin has also been installed at Kissing Point Park in Putney.

Solar power is used to compact the contents and alert waste collectors via an app when these bins are ready to be serviced. With six times the capacity of regular street bins, they will make it easier for everyone to enjoy a clean environment even on busy weekends.

This is a fantastic example of how technology can be used to improve service in local government, and I am grateful for the support from the NSW Environmental Protection Agency, which provided funding for this project.
