STAYING SMART ABOUT DOG OWNERSHIP

The Council has noticed a rise in dog ownership across our City following the COVID-19 pandemic. This has been common within Australia with a 2021 report from Animal Medicines Australia finding that more than one million additional dogs came into Australian households since 2019.

Dogs are fantastic companions and often bring a lot of joy into a home. However, it's also important that we look after our dogs responsibly and make sure that they don't cause harm to others. Dog training is a really good way of helping to socialise dogs and it can also help form a stronger bond between you and your canine friend. There are a number of organisations across the City, which provide these dog training services.

It's also important that pet owners follow rules around 'leash' and 'off-leash' areas as some dogs can become excited and cause harm to other people or animals. Finally, just a reminder for people to please clean up after their dogs as no one likes a dirty shoe.

Management of household finances is definitely an important topic at the moment with interest rates and costs of living increasing in recent months. There are also a number of scams happening within the community and targeting people through email and phones.
