HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL CLEANOUT

The Council will run a free household chemical cleanout next month. The chemical cleanouts are a great way of disposing of household chemicals safely and without causing added harm to the environment.

Each household will be able to dispose of up to 20 kilograms of a single chemical item or product. The chemical items can include: solvents and household cleaners, ammonia-based cleaners, pesticides and herbicides, poisons, pool chemicals, motor fuels, acids and alkalis, paint products and other items.

Residents should also take care in transporting the chemical items for cleanout including clearly labelling and sealing the items, keeping the items stable and away from passengers in the car and ensuring no chemicals are mixed or leaked.

Residents should also bring ID for the cleanout, which will take place from 9.00am to 3.30pm on Saturday 17 December 2022 at Meadowbank Park Netball Courts Car Park,

GET ON YOUR BIKE

The City of Ryde is set to hold an adult cycling skills workshop to help residents build their confidence in cycling. The workshop is designed for those who can ride a bike, but who would like to improve confidence and skills to enjoy riding more often.
