You may be familiar with James Squire from the beer that bears his name, but how many of you know the real-life story of the man behind the brand?

James Squire – Ratbag Thief to Patriarch of Kissing Point, an illustrated lecture being presented at Ryde Library on Thursday 20 April from 6.30 - 8.00pm by Peter Mitchell, takes a deep dive into Squire's eventful life.

The First Fleet convict and alleged protector of Governor Phillip became Australia's first commercial brewer, an Eastern Farms constable, a friend to the Kissing Point tribe, and a philanthropist.

Peter's lecture, which is part of the National Trust Australian Heritage Festival, will probe Squire's life in England, his convict days in America and NSW, his commercial achievements, and the evolving mythology about one of our 'larger than life' entrepreneurs.
