#### **MY FAREWELL AS MAYOR**

While the Extraordinary Council Meeting on 19 March marked my final City of Ryde Council meeting as Mayor I will remain as a Councillor until the Local Government Election in September 2024 which I will not be contesting.

There have been numerous highlights during my 20 years serving the community as a City of Ryde Councillor and Mayor including:

- Being first elected as an independent Councillor in 2004
- Joining the Liberal Party team in May 2010
- Becoming Mayor in December 2022 and being re-elected Mayor the following year
- Re-elected at each local government election since 2004 and holding the title of longest serving Councillor at the City of Ryde
- Serving as Deputy Mayor from September 2007 to August 2009 and from September 2021 to September 2022
- Being a member and Chair of numerous committees and advisory groups
- Being instrumental in gaining major initiatives such as the Shop Ryder bus service and the development of the Top Ryde Shopping Centre
- One of my first initiatives as a Councillor was to provide free entry to the Ryde Aquatic Leisure Centre for Ryde pensioners, which is still operational today
- I was the first elected Councillor in Australia of Armenian heritage
- In 2009 I was honoured to be awarded the OAM for service to local government and multicultural communities
- I've been active in the local SES since 2005.

I want to thank my fellow Councillors and the staff at City of Ryde for the

support I have received during my term as both a Councillor and Mayor and will continue to take a keen interest in the local area. I wish my successor as Mayor all the best.
